



PUBLIC NOTICE

The Electric Power Board of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County will hold a special-called, in-person meeting on Monday, February 9, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. to give an update on and discuss Winter Storm Fern. This meeting will be held at the Nashville Electric Service Building at 1214 Church Street, Nashville, TN 37246. The agenda includes a discussion of the Winter Storm Fern Response, a recommendation for approval to increase the emergency spending authority of the President and Chief Executive Officer and Executive Vice President for operational expenditures related to power restoration as a result of Winter Storm Fern, and a recommendation for approval to donate to the Winter Storm Recovery Fund.

The meeting is open to the general public, but space is extremely limited due to the size of the location and on-site parking limitations. NES can accommodate only up to 30 members of the general public beyond the public comment speaker submissions below, and priority will be given to the first 30 people who arrive. Security will be available for screening and intake at 7:45 a.m. The meeting will also be streamed live on NES' YouTube channel
