

Green Spaces Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) and Nashville

As winter gives way to spring, now is a great time to review your landscape. Look for signs of damage and take action. It is especially important to identify ash trees and look for signs of Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) infestation:

- Dead/dying branches near the top of the tree
- Leafy shoots sprouting along the trunks
- Woodpecker activity (called blonding)
- D-shaped exit holes
- Cracked/splitting bark revealing serpentine tunnels underneath

All ash trees native to Nashville are under attack from EAB and without treatment, will be devastated by this invasive species. A simple web search for EAB in TN will lead you to great information on ash trees and the EAB lifecycle. If you notice purple flagging and/or paint on your trees, contact NES Vegetation Management at 6I5-695-7400, as flagged trees may belong to a project to identify vegetation that may pose an increased risk to NES equipment and power lines. Dead, dying, and diseased trees can cause damage to your property also, so follow up with your preferred tree care provider. It is the homeowner's responsibility to manage those hazards.

How do I sign up?

Log into My Account at nespower.com or text "REG" to 637797 (NESPWR).

What if the power goes out?

Text "OUT" to 6.37797 (NESPWR) from your mobile device. NES will send you a text when power is restored.
